

## **Process**


any marked, bony prominence

### **Trochanter**


- a large process for attachment of muscle

#### **Foramen**




 an orifice through which blood vessels, nerves and ligaments pass

## **Spine**


 any sharp, slender projection, such as a spinous process

# **Tuberosity**


a large rounded process

# **Tubercle**


a small rounded process


## **Head**

# **Condyle**


