

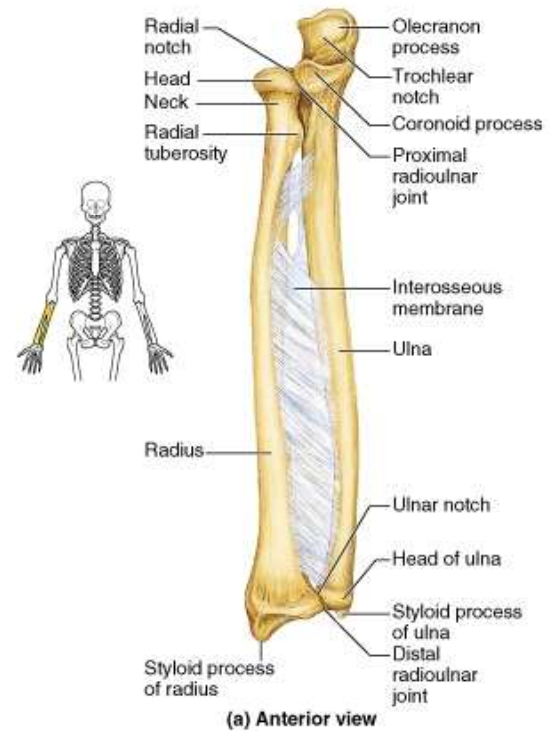


# **Terms to know for bones**



# Process

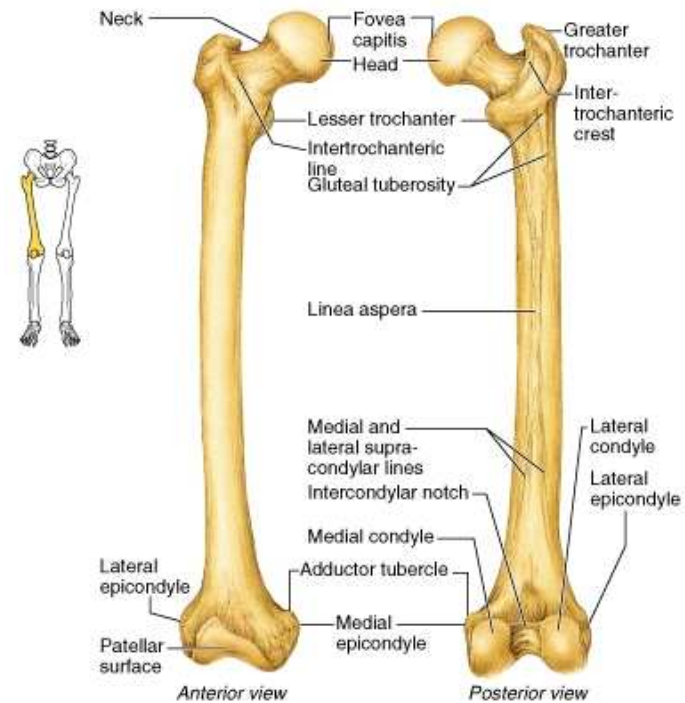
- any marked, bony prominence

# Trochanter

- a large process for attachment of muscle
- such as the one found on the femur

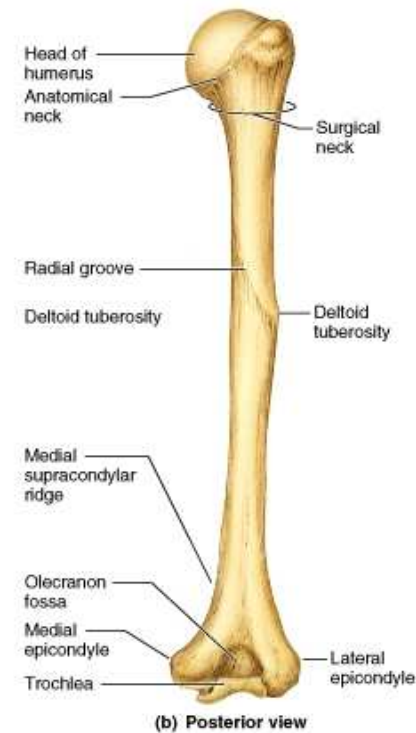


**(b) Femur**

# Fossa

- depression or cavity in or on a bone

# Foramen

- an orifice through which blood vessels, nerves and ligaments pass

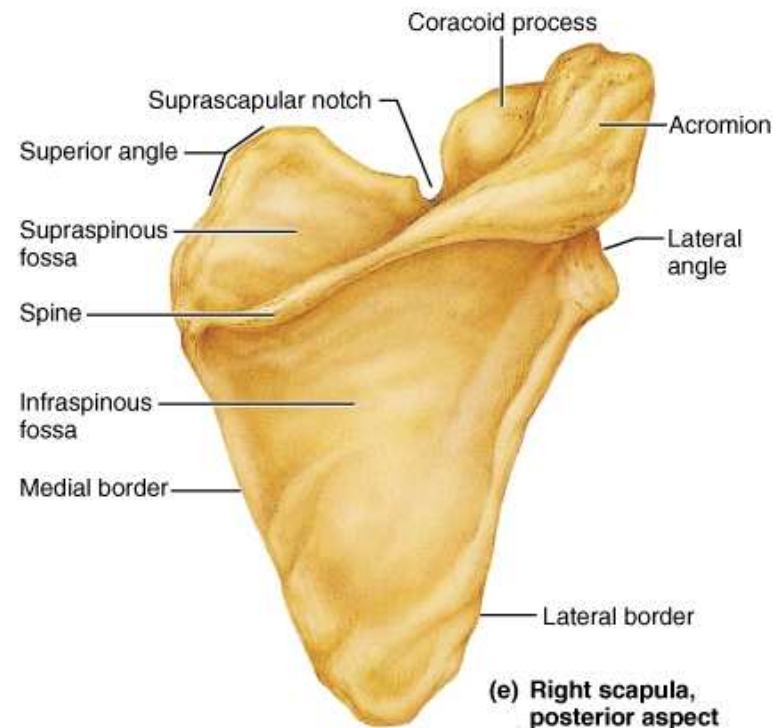

# Spine

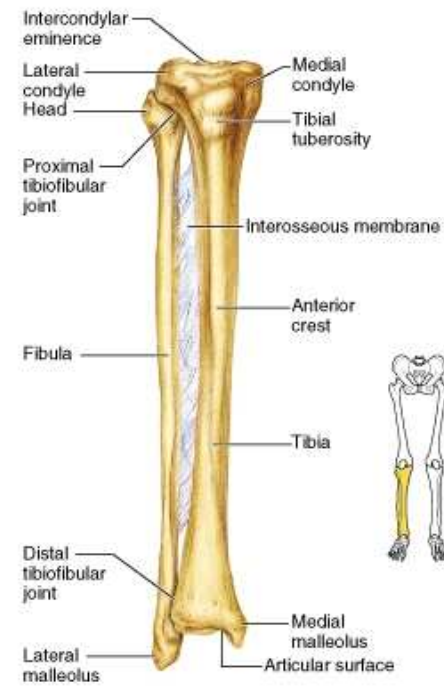
- any sharp, slender projection, such as a spinous process

# Tuberosity

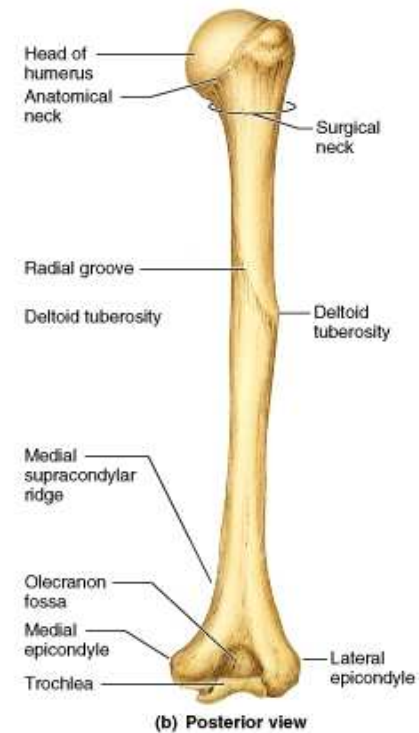
- a large rounded process

- a small rounded process

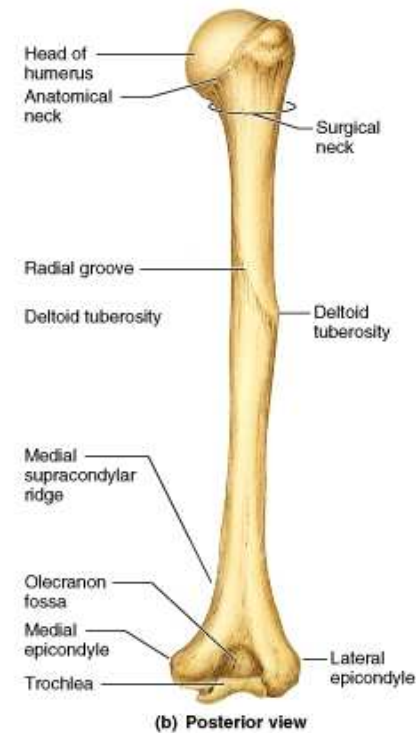

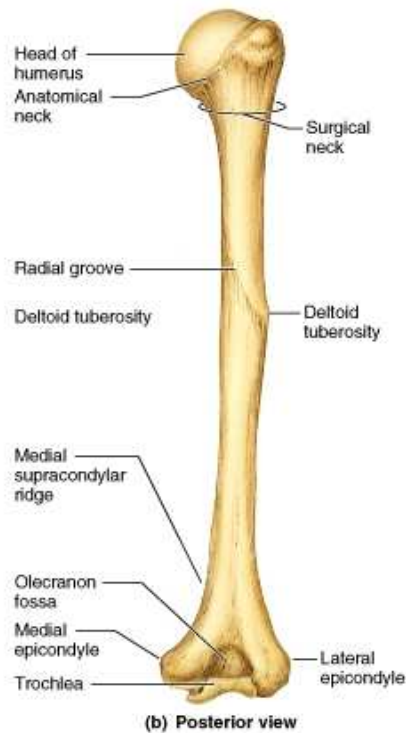
# Head

- terminal enlargement
- such as the head of the humerus

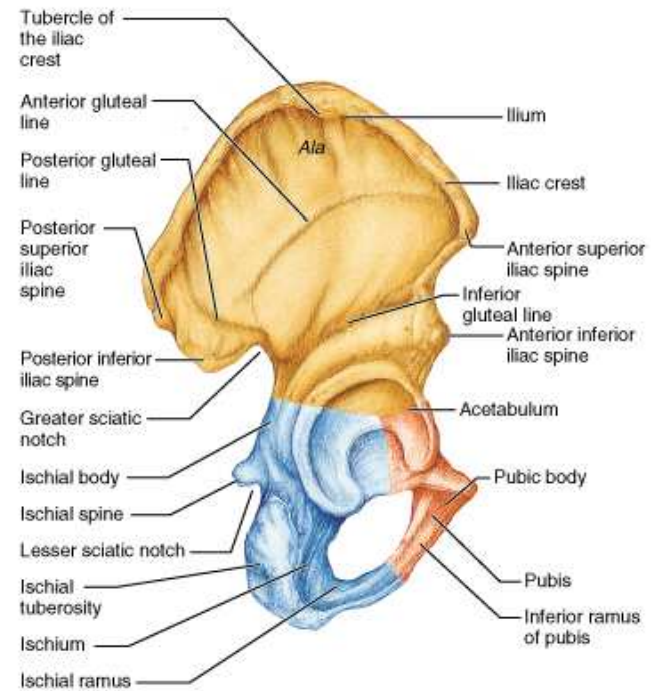
# Condyle



- rounded or knuckle-like prominence, usually at articulation points

# Crest

- a narrow ridge of bone
