## Lions

1. Lions are born leaders .

- Like to call the shots
- Self-motivated
- Resist being controlled by $\qquad$ others .

Cautions: be willing to $\qquad$ to others
2. Lions like to accomplish things/get $\qquad$ results .

- Powerful drive to achieve
- View life as a series of problems to $\qquad$ solve or challenges to meet

Caution: $\qquad$ relax ; don't put $\qquad$ projects ahead of people an/or make people_your projects.
3. A lion's time frame is now !

- Things get done
- Their intensity discourages interuptions_stupid questions

Caution: watch non-verbals ; can come across mad/intense, even when they aren't
4. Lions are $\qquad$ decisive .

- Can make decisions quickly (with or without the facts and/or advice)
- Not afraid to make $\qquad$ tough decisions

Caution: do consistent checks on how much

$\qquad$ they give loved ones in decisions that affect them
5. Lions want Readers's Digest length communication.

- Want the summary; stick to the $\qquad$ point
- Want to know what to $\qquad$ solve $\qquad$
- Want it to be $\qquad$ important $\qquad$
- Want to "do" rather than discuss

Caution: relational communication takes $\qquad$ time ; listening $\qquad$ conveys acceptance; most people don't want lectures or $\qquad$ solutions
6. Lions often feel challenged by questions.

- Questions may be interpreted as a personal challenge rather than a request for information

Caution: denying others the right to ask questions slams the door on their spirit \& on meaningful relationships; a loving home is more important than everyone's unquestioning loyalty
7. Lions are not afraid of pressure or confrontation.

- Put pressure on themselves and others
- Thrive on tension
- Can hurt other's feelings without realizing it

Caution: be careful not to $\qquad$ intimidate

## Beavers

1. Beavers keep a close watch on their $\qquad$ emotions .

- Reserved and cautious
- Controlled in displaying emotions and affection
- Sparing with praise

Caution: often have difficulty communicating
warmth
2. Beavers actually read $\qquad$ books.

- Careful and $\qquad$ instruction
- Does necessary detailed
- Want a $\qquad$ to follow

Caution: life/marriage/parenting are $\qquad$ unpredictable
3. Beavers like to make $\qquad$ decisions.

- Systematic
- Think through all sides of an issue
- Good decision - making instincts (but can let others talk them out of their well thought out plans)

Caution: may be so slow and/or cautious that they
$\qquad$ miss opportunities
4. Beavers like using their critical skills to solve problems.

- Examine issues critically
- Thorough/pain staking; loves details
- Enjoys reading maps
\& drawing diagrams
- Good at taking things apart (good at taking people apart)

Caution: may become critical, communicate intensity and/or keep others at a _ "safe" distance
5. Beavers live by the motto "Let's do this $\qquad$ right ."

- Organized
- Values precision and $\qquad$ (heads off making mistakes; Beaver career - surgeons)
- Corrects others (even on $\qquad$ minor $\qquad$ things)

Caution: can't see the main point for the details; may miss the message and the $\qquad$ behind it
6. Beavers tend to turn $\qquad$ anger inward.

- Will slow down under pressure $\qquad$
- Prone to depressions (attack themselves for making mistakes)
- Afraid to $\qquad$ fail
- Need supportive /non-critical atmosphere to do their best work

Caution: need permission to $\qquad$ and to reach out for $\qquad$ help

## Otters

1. Otters just want to have fun $\qquad$ .

- creative and spontaneous
- Are _parties just waiting to happen
- Enjoy surprises
- "Lighten - up"

Caution: tend to avoid serious discussions; may forget that there are consequences
2. Otters are great at $\qquad$ motivating others to action.

- Very convincing ; excellent motivators
- Natural gift of gab; can captivate an audience
- Provide energy and drive
- "Trust me"

Caution: need to think things through
3. Otters tend to avoid the fine print.

- Creative and artistic $\qquad$
- Don't read instructions
- Willing to try new things; willing to "wing it"

Caution: too casual an approach may lead to mistakes
4. Otters focus on the $\qquad$ future

- Optimistic (most problems are in the present/past)
- Rarely view problems as $\qquad$ as others
Caution: can $\qquad$ ignore or explain away
$\qquad$ problems; must respect other's
needs for a track record

5. Otters avoid confrontation $\qquad$ at all costs.

- Want to "spare" self and others
- Avoid/_ procrastinate dealing with problems and/or difficult discussions

Caution: may become manipulative and/or deceptive ; tend to verbally $\qquad$ when under pressure
6. Otters are tremendous $\qquad$

- Meet others easily ; often popular
- Know lots of people
- Great party/social planners
- Good at organizing events \& making phone calls

Caution: relationships are often $\qquad$ shallow
7. Otters are very susceptible to peer pressure.

- Want to be liked/_accepted , part of the group
- Impulsive
- People pleasers

Caution: may make $\qquad$ poor choices; suffer consequences

## Golden Retrievers

1. Above all, Golden Retrievers are loyal $\qquad$

- Can absorb the most emotional _ pain and stay committed to another person
- Willing to take the time $\qquad$ to listen, etc.
- Will lend a helping hand, even when $\qquad$ costly

Caution: may become an enabler or involved in a co-dependent relationship
2. Golden Retrievers have a strong need for close relationships.

- expect depth of sharing and feeling
- Develop life - long friendships
- Remember stories \& details of share past experiences

Caution: a lion's busyness with projects, a beaver's emotional reserve and an otter's outgoing personality may be very frustrating
3. Golden Retrievers have a deep need to please others.

- Want what's best for others
- Uncommon willingness to set aside their $\qquad$ need to serve others

Caution: may be taken $\qquad$ advantage of
4. Golden Retrievers have hearts full of compassion $\qquad$ .

- Patient and empathetic
- Good listeners
- Can spot the hurts of others, and want to help
- Very sensitive; wear their hearts on their sleeves

Caution: easily $\qquad$ by others; may take on too much
5. Golden Retrievers define the word adaptable $\qquad$ .

- Easy-going
- flexible

Caution: adapting on the outside is often at a high cost on the $\qquad$ inside (co-dependency, enabling)
6. Golden Retrievers often react to sudden
$\qquad$

- Need to _prepare them to change
- Will bare their $\qquad$ eth when left out of decisions
- Need extra time to think about big decision or moves

Caution: are vulnerable ; may go along, but will feel used
7. Golden Retrievers hold stubbornly to what they feel is $\qquad$ right .

- Many possess incredible courage and strength
- May put their life on the line to back up their convictions (movies: "Sergeant York," "Chariots of Fire")

Caution: may be stubbornly unwilling to consider other points of view
